






Full Marathon is Race #7 in the Ultra Trail Series 14 Mile Run is Race #6 in the Ultra Trail Lite Series

IMPORTANT NOTE: There will be a slight course change this year so that you all get a much bigger reward for your efforts in climbing up Hickory Nut Mountain. Instead you will come off trail at the top of the mountain, run up the dirt road to the vista at the very top. (See photo top right). This turn will be heavily marked and a course Marshall will be in place at the old aid station to point you in the correct direction. The Bayou Chapter of the Ozark Society also received an award for their trail work in the Ouachita National Forest. Dr. Perry Hill and Roy o'Neal were present to accept the award.

At this meeting at the Big Fork Community Center, David Samuel, retired Forester/Firefighter?ABF RD and Larry Sanders, Fire Chief for Big Fork Volunteer Fire Dept, opened the doors and gave a warm welcome to all present.

Dr Perry Hill presented the history of the Athens Big Fork Trail and it's past use as a postal route. Dr. Hill has done some extensive research, with the help of David Samuel to uncover all that they can on the history of the ABF trail and the area in general.

Dr. Revis Edmonds, Research and Programs Historian for the Arkansas Department of Parks, Heritage, and Tourism and for the AR Historic Preservation Program presented future possibilities for promotion and preservation of the ABF trail and the area.

Stacey, George, Perry, and Roy all presented the specific work on the Athens Big Fork trail by each perspective club.


